**WHYY'S MARTY MOSS-COANE TO INTERVIEW ED RENDELL  
DURING THIRD ANNUAL "A CONVERSATION WITH THE GOVERNOR"**

PHILADELPHIA, January 21, 2009 — WHYY's Marty Moss-Coane, host and executive producer of *Radio Times*, will interview Pennsylvania Gov. Ed Rendell on January 27 during the third annual "A Conversation With the Governor."

The program will be broadcast January 30 at 10 p.m. on WHYY TV.

Rendell likely will discuss challenges Pennsylvania faces in 2009 and offer solutions during the program, which will be set up in the Kimmel Center for the Performing Arts' Perelman Theater as a town hall-style meeting with an informal interview setting. Sovereign Bank is the title sponsor of "A Conversation With the Governor" and WHYY, media partner. The Greater Philadelphia Chamber of Commerce will host the event, expected to draw more than 400 business leaders and guests.

The governor may address Pennsylvania's \$1.9 billion shortfall in fiscal year 2009. Rendell will present a proposed 2009–2010 budget February 3. He may also offer insights on President Barack Obama's campaign and administration.

The interview will be taped from 4:30 to 5:30 p.m. News media are invited to cover the interview but must arrive no later than 4:15 sharp.

Moss-Coane has earned praise for her versatility and engaging conversations and interviews with guests and phone callers on *Radio Times*, a live two-hour program that covers social issues, public policy, books, films and more. *Radio Times* is produced at WHYY, the region's leading public broadcasting station.
