**WHYY'S DELAWARE TONIGHT  
TO BROADCAST SPECIAL ON STATE OF THE STATE APRIL 28**

PHILADELPHIA, April 23, 2009 — In a special one-hour episode of *Delaware Tonight*, WHYY will rebroadcast Delaware Gov. Jack Markell's April 28 address given before a joint session of the state legislature earlier that day.

Markell and the legislature face challenges in how to chip away at a \$750 million-plus deficit just two months before the 2009-10 budget must be passed.

Stephanie Aldrich will anchor the program, which will be broadcast from 5 to 6 p.m. on WHYY TV (analog and 12.1) and 6 to 7 p.m. on Y Info. *Delaware Tonight's* ongoing commitment to provide in-depth coverage of the budgetary process will also include analysis by Bill Cook, WHYY's Dover bureau chief, who covers the legislature.
