From his humble origins in Modena, Italy, *A Life in Seven Arias* follows "the King of the High C's" meteoric rise, spanning through his London debut in *La Boheme*, his triumph in *La fille du regiment*, and his iconic rendition of "Nessun Dorma." In addition to a treasure trove of classic Pavarotti performances, also featured are new and archival interviews with many of the tenor's friends and colleagues, including Dame Joan Sutherland, Placido Domingo, Jose Carreras, and Juan Diego Florez.

### **Antiques Road Show, Philadelphia**

**Monday, March 2, 7:30 – 9:00:p.m.**

Philadelphia, Pennsylvania has the distinction of being one of the stops in Roadshow's first season, taped in 1996. Fast forward to 2007 and Roadshow is back "where it all began" for the popular PBS series, as well as for the United States. Host Mark L. Walberg kicks off the show with a visit to a Philadelphia landmark—the Philadelphia Art Museum. The museum's collection is so large and diverse; it takes eight ROADSHOW experts to do it justice. At the Pennsylvania Convention Center, nearly 70 experts offer their opinions of the approximately 10,000 objects brought for appraisal, including a rare eighteenth-century Pennsylvania spice cupboard used to collect birds egg specimens; a very valuable mid-seventeenth-century needlework piece bought at auction by a savvy collector for next to nothing; and an early twentieth-century nicotine stained oil painting by noted Pennsylvania impressionist George Sotter—banished to a flooded basement by the owner—valued at \$120,000 to \$180,000.

The star of *Dudu Fisher: In Concert from Israel* is best known for his stirring portrayal of "Jean Valjean" in the hit musical *Les Miserables*, which he performed in Israel, London's West End and on Broadway. Prior to that, he served as cantor for the Great Synagogue of Tel Aviv, where he sang traditional Hassidic, Yiddish and cantorial music to worldwide audiences. Fisher has also recorded 20 albums, sang the role of "Moses" in the Hebrew version of Steven Spielberg's *The Prince of Egypt* and performed with the Zubin Mehta-led Israel Philharmonic Orchestra.

program also boasts performances by Little Anthony & The Imperials, Lenny Welch and a surprise appearance by Little Richard, who burns up the stage with an exhilarating performance of "Keep A-Knockin'."

#### **Discovering the Secrets of the Vatican**

**Friday, March 6, 10:00- 11:30 p.m.**

**Sunday, March 8, 7:30 – 9:00 p.m.**

The Vatican is one of the most visited tourist destinations in the world. It is separated from Rome only by its bordering walls and travertine pavement. Unknown to many, the city state has a president who oversees the Vatican's internal governmental affairs. In the program, a Vatican guard's wife shares her perspective on the mandatory dress code as well as the limited displays of affection permitted within the walls of the city state. Vatican guards are equivalent to the United States' Secret Service, ensuring the safety of the Pope. A Vatican guard is a very prestigious position only granted to those who are Swiss born. On average, 25,000 people stroll the halls of the Vatican museums each day. The program highlights the past and present transportation vehicles of the Pope and reveals the breathtaking sight of Michelangelo's beautifully restored Sistine Chapel, which took over 15 years to complete. The documentary also features a visit into St. Peter's tomb and concludes by celebrating the ordainment of new priests at the Vatican.

#### **Lidia's Italy: Tutto Pasta**

**Saturday, March 7, 3:00 – 3:45 p.m.**

Lidia heads to Naples to discover the secrets of the wine of Feudi di San Gregorio, a region with its own unique soil — and some great new varietals. Back in the kitchen it's an all pasta menu of maltagliata with onion-tomato sauce, fettuccine with squash and cauliflower, and spaghetti with a quick garlic-tomato sauce.

#### **Lidia's Italy: Vegetarian Roman**

**Saturday, March 7, 3:30 – 4:15 p.m.**

Lidia explores Rome through the eyes of a vegetarian, paying special attention to the wonderful produce and cheese that Roman cuisine has to offer. Back in the kitchen, it's an all vegetarian menu of roasted potatoes with small artichokes, braised large artichokes with pecorino, and perciatelli- a long, tubular pasta- with artichokes braised in tomato sauce.

#### **Lidia's Italy: The Best Focaccia Ever**

**Saturday, March 7, 4:15 – 4:45 p.m.**

It's time to bake with Lidia! In Altamura, Lidia shows the traditional methods of bread making. Then back in the kitchen, Lidia is joined by three bakers in training- her grandsons, Lorenzo, Miles and Ethan. Together they make personalized focaccia with toppings like onions and tomatoes and mozzarella and basil. Then Lidia puts together a sweet treat- caramelized almond wafers.

#### **Lidia's Italy: To Crumb or Not to Crumb**

**Saturday, March 7, 4:45 – 5:30 p.m.**

Lidia travels to Treviso to learn of the city's two treasures: their beautiful architecture and their prized produce - radicchio. Back in the kitchen, Lidia is joined by Chef Mark Ladner of Del Posto, where they indulge in risotto with radicchio and a peach tart with cocoa almond crust.

#### **Highland Heartbeat**

**Saturday, March 7, 5:30 - 7:00 p.m.**

Singer/actress Fiona Kennedy, a member of Scotland's leading theatrical family and well-known in North America as the host of "Tartan TV," leads a group of singers brought together from a country-wide audition to represent a range of musical styles. Singers Jim Malcolm, Jillian Isbister, Maureen McMullan, Daisy Chute and Darren Maclean perform at the historic Theatre Royal in Glasgow backed by the Scottish Festival Orchestra. The men wear the traditional Scottish kilt, and the women wear modern designs that riff on traditional Scottish themes. Emmy Award-winning Scottish actor Brian



Cox (*The Bourne Supremacy*) reads the works of Scotland's national bard, Robert Burns, with stunning footage of Scotland interspersed between songs. The concert was shot in high definition in August 2008.

**Chris Botti: Live In Boston**

Trumpeter Chris Botti is a gifted instrumentalist and a charismatic performer who, since the release of his first solo album in 1995, has created a series of recordings which have made him a virtual genre-of-one in the realm of contemporary jazz while at the same time capturing the attention of the pop music world. Featuring Sting, Lucia Micarelli, John Mayer, Josh Groban, Katharine McPhee, Yo-Yo Ma, Steven Tyler, and Sy Smith, this event was filmed in beautiful high definition video at Symphony Hall in Boston, with Keith Lockhart conducting The Boston Pops. These incredible, world-famous artists join with Chris to give masterful performances selecting material different from the repertoire that one might associate with them.

Despite the release of a host of hit singles including "Roxanne," "Message in a Bottle," and "Every Breath You Take," five smash albums, and six Grammy Awards between 1980 and 1984, the Police parted ways in 1986, with front-man Sting embarking on a hugely successful solo career.
